

An MLA works cited page is a list of sources at the end of a research paper.

A works cited page starts on a new page and is numbered (upper right hand corner) as a continuation of the paper. (last name and page number, 1/2" from top of page)

Sources listed on a wc page are alphabetized by the author's last name. When no author is given, alphabetize by article title, ignoring "A", "An" and "The" if one of these is the first word.

Use a five space (hit the tab button) indentation for all lines after the first line of a citation entry. (This is called a hanging indentation.)

Double-space the entire list. Font should be Times New Roman, size 12.
